*Festival Hours are from 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM.

*Vendors must furnish needed electrical cords and water hoses. Vendors are required to keep their booths open during these hours. If it is necessary for you to close your booth, you can not breakdown and remove your items until closing at 5pm. The streets will remain closed for vehicle access from 7:00 am until 5:30 pm.

*Sidewalks are not to be used by vendors.

*Setup and breakdown of space: Once you arrive please unload your vehicle at your assigned space and then move your vehicle to the assigned parking spaces for vendors. You will not be allowed to leave your vehicle parked on the street during your setup because this detains other vendors who are trying to load or unload. Due to limited space on the streets, please bring as few vehicles as possible to your setup site.

* The Wayne County Health Department will be inspecting all food vendors. You must comply with the requirements to be permitted. Any questions concerning this should be directed to the health department. The Daffodil Committee is not responsible for vendors not complying with the requirements and application fees will not be refunded due to failure of inspections.

Application Deadlines: Applications must be received by March 10, 2024. Any application received after this date will be charged a \$25.00 late fee.

The Fremont Daffodil Festival Foundation Inc. reserves the right to approve or deny any application. The Foundation is not responsible for damages, injury or loss to any person or goods.
